What do my HOA fees go towards?

If you are receiving this letter, you live in the Clearfork Hills III Homeowners Association. Like stated above, the benefit of being part of an HOA is that it helps keep homes in our neighborhood neat and tidy which keeps our property value up. Please remember that there are rules in place that need to be followed. A list of rules and covenants can be given at any time.

Below are the approximant costs:

Common area mowing-\$6500 Per year

Insurance = \$1000 per year


Taxes= \$850 Per year

Due to it being early in the season, we do not yet know what trees in the common areas need cleaned up-Tree maintenance and clean up in the common areas is a part of our dues and will be addressed. Please contact Ray with any common area tree concerns.

Yearly Dues are \$100 per home with an early-bird discount of \$80. If you would like to pay ahead for 2 years, it would be \$145 to cover 2019 and 2020.
